

Unit (# of beds)	Floor	Description
Behavioral Health (12 beds)	Ground Northeast	Inpatient mental health unit primarily caring for patients with bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, major depressive disorder, or substance abuse disorders.
Emergency (25 beds)	1st	Care of severe or sudden onset illnesses or injuries for an average of 95 patients per day, including pediatrics. Chest pain and stroke accredited. Trauma patients are stabilized and transferred to advanced-level trauma facilities.
Intensive Care Unit (8 beds)	1st	Critical patient population which includes anyone in need of extensive physiological support, including those with heart failure, respiratory failure, renal failure, multi-system failure, complex electrolyte imbalances, and complicated surgeries with intravenous infusions, extensive monitoring, and ventilator support capabilities.
Maternity/NICU (5 L&D, 8 PP, & 6 NICU)	2nd	Supports women through antepartum, labor, delivery, recovery, and postpartum care. Two triage beds are utilized for complex situations requiring diagnostics and assessment screening. NICU cares for high-risk neonates from 32 weeks gestation through 28 days post-term.
Perioperative (8 ORs)	1st	Provides both inpatient and outpatient surgeries, including ENT, orthopedic (including joint replacement), gastrointestinal, genitourinary, podiatry, and general surgery cases. Also includes endoscopy and an obstetric operating suite.
Progressive Care Unit (19 beds)	3rd	Complex patient population which includes cardiac, pulmonary, renal, gastrointestinal, and multi-system disorders with antiarrhythmic/vasoactive medication infusions and bedside monitoring capabilities.
Telemetry/Med-Surg (42 beds)	2nd	Care for a broad spectrum of medical and surgical patients, including elective joint replacement post-surgical care. All beds have capability of telemetry monitoring. Also a designated stroke unit.
